IN THE MATTER OF an expiry review, pursuant to subsection 76.03(1) of the *Special Import Measures Act*, of the order made by the Canadian International Trade Tribunal on May 31, 2018, in expiry review RR-2017-002, continuing, without amendment, its finding made on November 20, 2012, in inquiry NQ-2012-001, continued, without amendment, by its order made on May 31, 2016, in interim review RD-2013-003, concerning:

The Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to subsection 76.03(1) of the *Special Import Measures Act* (SIMA), has conducted an expiry review of its order made on May 31, 2018, in expiry review RR-2017-002, continuing, without amendment, its finding made on November 20, 2012, in inquiry NQ-2012-001, continued, without amendment, by its order made on May 31, 2016, in interim review RD-2013-003, concerning the dumping of liquid dielectric transformers having a top power handling capacity equal to or exceeding 60,000 kilovolt amperes (60 megavolt amperes), whether assembled or unassembled, complete or incomplete, originating in or exported from the Republic of Korea.
