Application No. EP-2014-002

Tri-Ed Ltd.

Order issued Tuesday, February 24, 2015 IN THE MATTER OF an application made by Tri-Ed Ltd., pursuant to section 67.1 of the *Customs Act*, for an order extending the time to file a notice of appeal, pursuant to section 67 of the *Customs Act*, with respect to a decision of the President of the Canada Border Services Agency dated October 16, 2014.

## ORDER
