IN THE MATTER OF an application made by J. Rampal, pursuant to section 60.2 of the *Customs Act*, for an order extending the time to file requests for further re-determination pursuant to section 60 of the *Customs Act*.

ORDER

Having considered the submissions of J. Rampal, having noted that the President of the Canada Border Services Agency does not object to the above-mentioned application, and being satisfied that the requirements and conditions set out in section 60.2 of the *Customs Act* have been met, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal grants the application for an extension of time and gives J.
