ORDER

In its determination of April 7, 2014, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded Star Group International Trading Corporation its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for the complaint case was Level 1, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$1,000.

After considering the submissions of the parties concerning that determination, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal hereby confirms its preliminary indication that the level of complexity of this case is Level 1 and awards Star Group International Trading Corporation its costs in the amount of \$1,150 for preparing and proceeding with the complaint, in accordance with the *Guideline for Fixing Costs in Procurement Complaint Proceedings*,¹ and directs Defence Construction (1951) Limited to take appropriate action to ensure prompt payment.
