ORDER

In its determination of August 5, 2005, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded MTS Allstream Inc., Call-Net Enterprises Inc. and TELUS Communications Inc. their reasonable costs incurred in filing the complaint. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for this complaint case was Level 3, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$4,100.
