ORDER

In its determination of August 2, 2006, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded the Department of Public Works and Government Services its reasonable costs incurred in responding to the complaint.
