ORDER

In its determination of May 1, 2007, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded the Department of Public Works and Government Services its reasonable costs incurred in responding to the complaint.
