In its determination of November 2, 2006, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act, awarded Lengkeek Vessel Engineering Incorporated its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint.
