ORDER

In its determination of December 18, 2007, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded the Department of Public Works and Government Services its reasonable costs incurred in responding to the complaint. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for this complaint case was Level 1, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$1,000.
