ORDER

In its determination of December 20, 2006, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded Antian Professional Services Inc. its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint.
