ORDER

In its determination of June 11, 2007, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded BDMK Consultants Inc. its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint.
