ORDER

In its determination of September 25, 2008, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded Bluedrop Performance Learning Inc. its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint.
