ORDER

In its determination of April 14, 2010, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded Krista Dunlop & Associates Inc. its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint.
