**ORDER**

In its determination of February 14, 2013, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded the National Gallery of Canada its reasonable costs incurred in responding to the complaint. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for the complaint case was Level 1, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$1,000. Noting that there have been no submissions contesting the preliminary indication of the level of complexity or the preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal hereby confirms its preliminary indications by awarding the National Gallery of Canada its costs in the amount of \$1,000 for responding to the complaint and directs C3 Polymeric Limited to take appropriate action to ensure prompt payment.
