ORDER

In its determination of October 17, 2011, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded the Canada Revenue Agency its reasonable costs incurred in responding to the complaints. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for the complaint cases was Level 2, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$2,400. Noting that there have been no submissions contesting the preliminary indication of the level of complexity or the preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal hereby confirms its preliminary indications by awarding the Canada Revenue Agency its costs in the amount of \$2,400 for responding to the complaints and directs the Access Information Agency Inc. to take appropriate action to ensure prompt payment.
