ORDER

In its determination of November 23, 2018, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded the Department of Public Works and Government Services its reasonable costs incurred in responding to the complaints. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the levels of complexity for the complaints was Level 2 and Level 1 for Files No. PR-2018-014 and PR-2018-024, respectively, and its preliminary indication of the total amount of the cost award was \$3,900.
