IN THE MATTER OF a complaint filed by the University of Saskatchewan pursuant to subsection 30.11(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, R.S.C., 1985, c. 47 (4th Supp.);

AND FURTHER TO a decision to conduct an inquiry into the complaint pursuant to subsection 30.13(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*;

AND FURTHER TO a motion filed by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada requesting that the Canadian International Trade Tribunal cease the inquiry on the grounds that the process which is the subject of the complaint does not constitute “government procurement” for the purposes of the trade agreements and does not constitute a “designated contract” for the purposes of subsection 30.11(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, as defined by section 30.1 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act* and section 3 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Regulations*.
