**ORDER**

In its determination of October 16, 2019, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to subsection 30.15(4) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded Pacific Northwest Raptors Ltd. its reasonable bid preparation costs. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal acknowledges the information filed by the parties, indicating that the parties have reached an agreement on bid preparation costs. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal therefore considers the matter of bid preparation costs to be closed.

The Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, also awarded Pacific Northwest Raptors Ltd. its costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with the complaint. The Canadian International Trade Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for the complaint case was Level 1, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$1,150. Noting that there have been no submissions contesting the preliminary indication of the level of complexity or the preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal hereby confirms its preliminary indications by awarding Pacific Northwest Raptors Ltd. its costs in the amount of \$1,150 and directs the Department of Public Works and Government Services to take appropriate action to ensure prompt payment.
