ORDER

In its determination of November 10, 2021, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal, pursuant to section 30.16 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, awarded Rampart International Corporation its reasonable costs incurred in preparing and proceeding with its complaints. The Tribunal's preliminary indication of the level of complexity for the complaint case was Level 3, and its preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award was \$4,700. Noting that there have been no submissions contesting the preliminary indication of the level of complexity or the preliminary indication of the amount of the cost award, the Tribunal hereby confirms its preliminary indications by awarding Rampart International Corporation its costs in the amount of \$4,700 for preparing and proceeding with the complaints and directs the Department of Public Works and Government Services to take appropriate action to ensure prompt payment.
