ORDER

WHEREAS Amazon Web Services, Inc. (Amazon) filed the above-mentioned complaint on March 9 and 10, 2021;

AND WHEREAS the Canadian International Trade Tribunal decided, on March 15, 2021, to inquire into the complaint, pursuant to subsection 30.13(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act (CITT Act)* and subsection 7(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Procurement Inquiry Regulations*;

AND WHEREAS, on April 8, 2021, Amazon withdrew its complaint and indicated that each party had agreed to cover its own costs;

AND WHEREAS Shared Services Canada confirmed, on April 9, 2021, that it was in agreement that each party would bear its own costs;

AND WHEREAS subsection 30.13(5) of the *CITT Act* provides that the Tribunal may cease conducting the inquiry;

THEREFORE, pursuant to subsection 30.13(5) of the *CITT Act*, the Tribunal hereby ceases its inquiry. Each party shall bear its own costs.
