DECISION

Pursuant to subsection 30.13(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal has decided not to conduct an inquiry into the complaint.

With respect to the allegation that the Department of Public Works and Government Services unreasonably refused to accept Denys Petika Management, Administration, Consulting Inc.'s experience in residential window installation, the Tribunal finds that this ground of complaint was not filed within the time limits prescribed by section 6 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Procurement Inquiry Regulations* (Regulations).

With respect to the other grounds of complaint, the Tribunal finds that they do not meet the condition set out in subparagraph 7(1)(c)(i) of the Regulations because they do not disclose a reasonable indication of a breach of the applicable trade agreement.
