### **DECISION**

Pursuant to subsection 30.13(1) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act*, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal has decided not to conduct an inquiry into the complaint, because the complaint was not filed within the time limits prescribed by section 6 of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Procurement Inquiry Regulations* (Regulations). In any event, even if the complaint had been filed in a timely way, the Tribunal would have found that the complaint does not meet the condition set out in subparagraph 7(1)(c)(i) of the Regulations, as it does not disclose a reasonable indication of a breach of the relevant trade agreements.
