The solicitation was for the provision of environmental DNA analysis services. Pursuant to subsection 30.13(2) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Act* and subsection 7(2) of the *Canadian International Trade Tribunal Procurement Inquiry Regulations*, notice is given that the Tribunal made a decision on June 19, 2025, to conduct an inquiry into the complaint.

eDNAtec alleges that PWGSC improperly awarded the contract to the University of Guelph, because the University is unfairly subsidized and its bid did not satisfy the technical requirements of the Request for Standing Offer.
